- 8 Describe any two of Kenzo Tange's works. (20 Marks)

- 9 Demonstrate Brutalism as seen in the modern buildings of any two architects. (20 Marks)

- 10 Identify and elaborate on any two modernist buildings where contribution of the structural engineer is imminent. (20 Marks)
